

Jump for Charity

Why not do your first skydive for charity? If you raise the minimum amount (see below) then you can do your skydive for free and at the same time you could help a charity to raise vital funds!

This is the route that many first time jumpers choose to take and you'll be surprised at how easy and fun it is to find the sponsorship.

Below is the minimum sponsorship amount required, this covers the cost of your jump and includes £140 for your chosen charity:

If you raise the minimum amount of sponsorship, we guarantee our charities will receive at least £140, with the remaining money paying for your skydive/parachute jump and deposit.

How it Works – the Basics

Minimum Sponsorship required:

Tandem Skydive £390

Accelerated Free Fall Level 1 £550

Static Line Parachute Jump £365

An Example - Tandem Skydive at Skydive London

Total to raise	£390
Deposit	£70
Minimum amount to charity*	£140

*any amount raised over this figure must be sent to Skydive Zone and we will forward to your Charity.

Breakdown of Procedures:

Stage 1

Decide on which charity you would like to raise money for and contact us with your details and charity name. If you have a charity which is close to you and that isn't on our charity list please let us know and we can arrange this for you.

Stage 2

An information pack will be sent to you.

Stage 3

Send your completed booking form and signed Terms & Conditions back to us with your £70 deposit. You can reimburse yourself this amount with your sponsor money, once collected.

Stage 4

We arrange your skydive / parachute jump at your preferred dropzone on your preferred date (you can jump throughout the year).

Stage 5

Once we have completed your booking, you will receive a confirmation letter, dropzone details (arrival, time, clothing, map etc) and a sponsor form.

Stage 6

We will require the minimum sponsor money of £140 in cheque form, made payable to your charity, in the week prior to your jump. You may need to pay this yourself until you collect your sponsor money, therefore, for your convenience, this cheque can be post-date for up to 1 month so you are able to reimburse yourself prior to the funds being taken from your bank account.

Stage 7

You attend the parachute centre to complete your jump. At this time you will pay the balance of your jump fee directly to the parachute centre, unless stated otherwise in your confirmation letter.

Stage 8

Let us know that you have completed your jump so that we can forward your sponsorship money to your charity without delay.
